Ticket sales will be cut 50/50 once the 100 seats to break even are filled. There will be no splitting of profits from auction items.
- The committee discussed previous Balls and how the auction items have been procured in the past. Vanessa will follow up on professional auctioneers to determine costs. Other team members to follow up.
- Discussed teachers, catering and parents who may be able to provide auction items. We would really like to have the senior school parents get involved. We really need volunteers to help gather these auction items.
- Look at photo booths and a photographer to attend. Vanessa to follow up with photo booth and Jo to check on photographers.
