Summary

The 2018/19 academic year has been another successful year for the CHSA, with over:

- **£6,900 profit raised from events and uniform sales**
- **£7,600 distributed to the school**

Profits raised also come after a number of long term investments, such as our popcorn machine and new Christmas tree and decorations, which will be used for years to come. We are also carrying a large level of gift stock for our Christmas Grotto.

Note that CHSA continue to hold over funds from previous years' profits and have to date (after committed expenditure) in the region of **£7,600 available for distribution**.

Our events not only raise valuable funds used by the entire school, but are also really fun for the pupils, particularly in the Lower School.
